Total current (Jul-2020) Bay Area employment of 3,651,200 is 511,500 below the recent peak figure of 4,162,700. The labor force is 172,100 below the recent peak figure of 4,256,400. Job growth (loss) over the past three months was 178,900 versus 34,300 for the same period last year. Mar-2020 represents the first month of significant job loss due to the Covid-19 virus. Recent growth reflects partial reopening of the local economy.
