Total current (May-2021) Bay Area employment of 3,744,900 is 405,700 below the recent peak figure of 4,150,600 and the all-time high of 4,174,300 set in Dec-2018. The labor force is 290,600 below the recent peak figure of 4,248,000 and the all-time high of 4,284,700 set in Nov-2018. Job growth (loss) over the past three months was 12,800 versus -596,800 for the same period last year. Mar-2020 represents the first month of significant job loss due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
