Total current (March 2022) Bay Area employment of 3,996,900 sets the peak figure for the past 18 months but is below the all-time high of 4,174,300 set in December 2018. The labor force is 45,800 below the recent peak figure of 4,161,600 and the all-time high of 4,284,700 set in November 2018. Job growth over the past three months was 74,100 versus -68,300 for the same period last year. March 2020 represents the first month of significant job loss due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
